



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Hon^{ble} bearing Date the 30^d day of Oct^r 1732 I have Surveyed and laid out unto John Deardolph on a Branch of Codorus Creek in the County of Lancaster on the West Sid^e Susquehanna river in right of Mark Farney one hund and sixty five Acres of Land With allowance of six p Cent Beginning at a Black oak a Corn^r of Henry Davie's Land Thence North Sixty Degrees Westerly Two hundred Perches to a Hickery Thence South thirty Degrees Westerly one hundred and forty Perches to a post Thence South Sixty Degrees Easterly Two hundred Perches to a Post Thence North thirty Degrees Easterly one hundred and forty Perches to the Place of Beginning
