

Christian Miller & Christian Berger

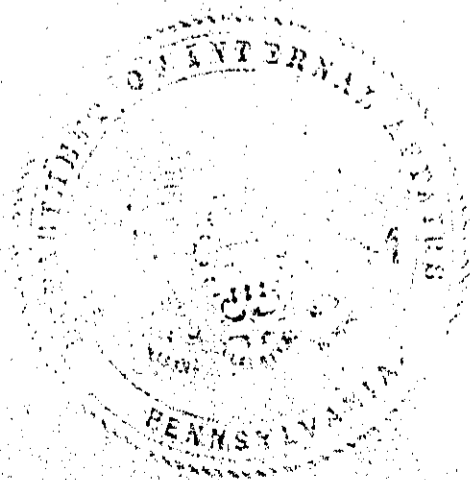
