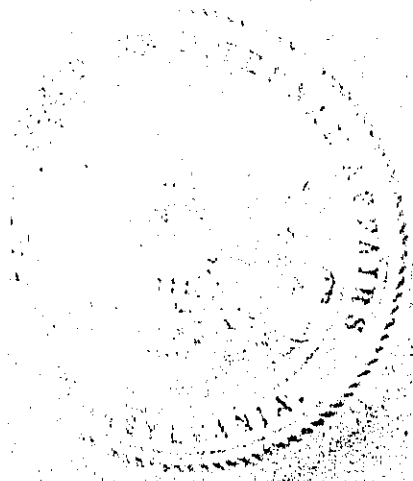


The above Draught describes an Addition of 14<sup>a</sup> & allowance as usual, Survey'd for Robert Tweed the 10<sup>th</sup> of the 3<sup>rd</sup> mo: 1756. In pursuance of a Warrant bearing Date the 3<sup>rd</sup> of the Month called January preceding; in Sadsbury Township <sup>I believe</sup> Lancaster County laid down by a Scale of 40<sup>r</sup>. to an Acre by Geo: Churchman D.S.
