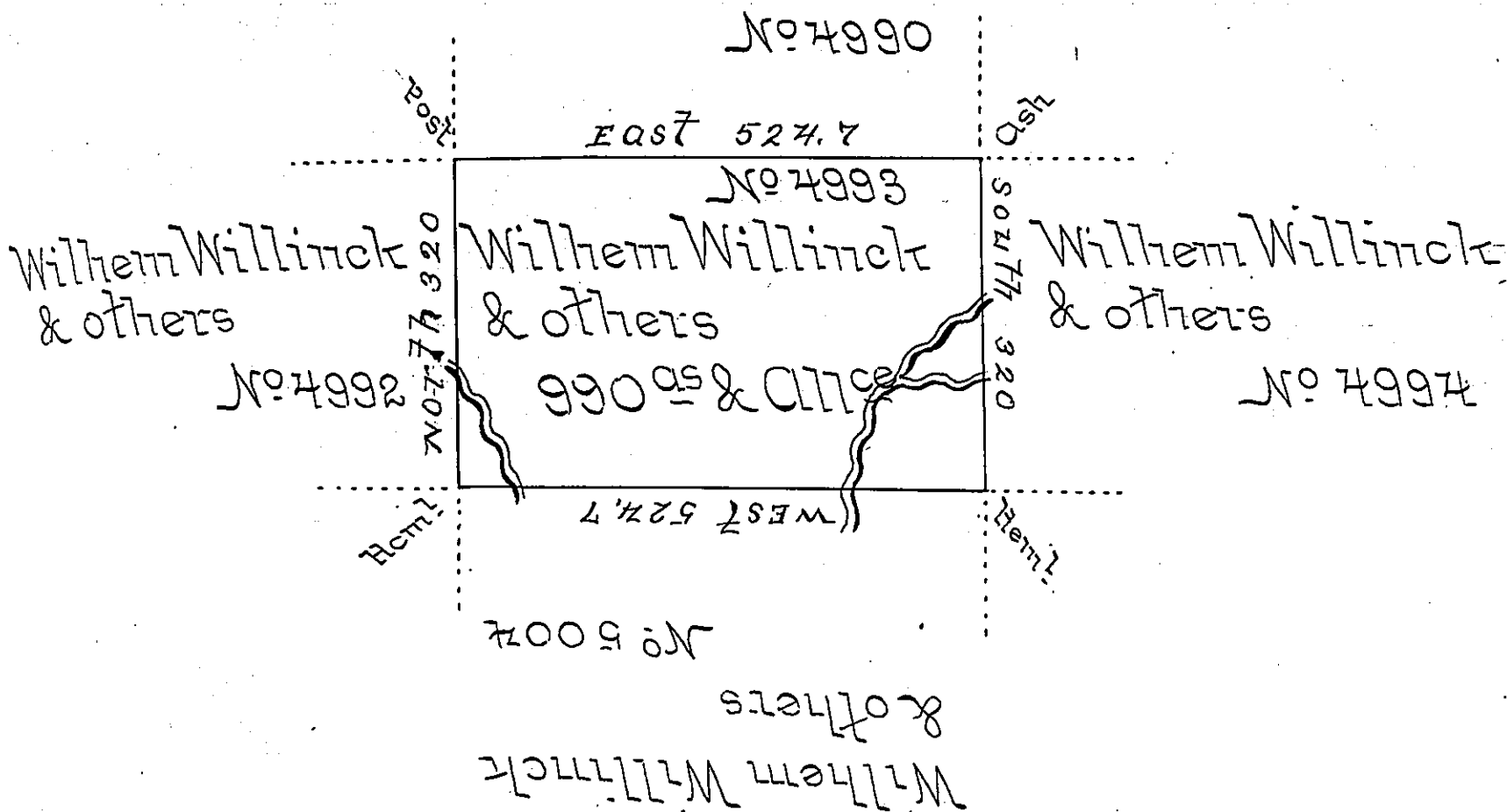

In pursuance of a warrant No 4993 dated <sup>3rd</sup> February 1794 surveyed the 25<sup>th</sup> day of August 1794 to Wilhem Willinck, Nicolaas Van Staphorst, Christiaan Van Beq<sup>h</sup>en, Pieter Stadnitski, Hendrick Vallenhoven and Rutger Jan Schimmel penninck of Amsterdam the above discribed tract of land Situate in District No 3 in the late purchase Northumberland County containing nine hundred & ninety Acres and the Allowance of Six P<sup>er</sup> Cent for Roads &c.
