Resurveyed (agreeable to a Draft signed George Stephenson & Stevenson said thereon to be a true Copy taken from a draft found among the papers of Thomas Cookson Esq.) the 22^d April 1796, in pursuance of directions from the Surveyor General on an Order of the Hon^{ble} the Board of Property granted the 25th February 1796 to the petition of T. M. Murrain Gardner who claims the land by Virtue of a warrant granted to James Gardner dated the 12th day of November 1742, which tract is claimed by the heirs of James Wilson, who appear to be in possession of the Land and say they have a patent for the same.
