



The above Draught contains 6 perches strict measure being an Island in the River Susquehanna in Drumore Township Lancaster County, called Maple Island. Opposite the mouth of Muddy Creek, about five hundred yards from the Lancaster shore, at the foot of Neeles deep, and about two hundred yards across from the point of Hares Island towards the Lancaster shore. Surveyed in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Hugh Johnston dated the 28<sup>th</sup> of January, 1819, and now surveyed the 4<sup>th</sup> day of June 1835
