Situate in Derry Townsh<sup>p</sup>. Lancaster County. By Warrant of the 15<sup>th</sup> day of February 1754, J. Bartrem Galbraith D. J.

N.B. there was no land for the Warrant agreeable to the Location of the ~~Warr~~ same, therefore I survey'd this in Derry on the 13<sup>th</sup>.
