



The above is a draught of an Island, in the river Susquehanna in Martick Township, Lancaster County, Called Rhode Island; opposite Lands of the Widow Curry on the Lancaster Shore, Lands of William Gizzon & Hans Ringland, on the York Shore, and about forty perches, south of Little Rockey Island, and about two perches North of Bear Island, being unimproved, and contains one acre and forty nine perches, strictly measured, & surveyed in pursuance of a Warrant granted to James L. McCarr dated the 13th day of October 1831.
