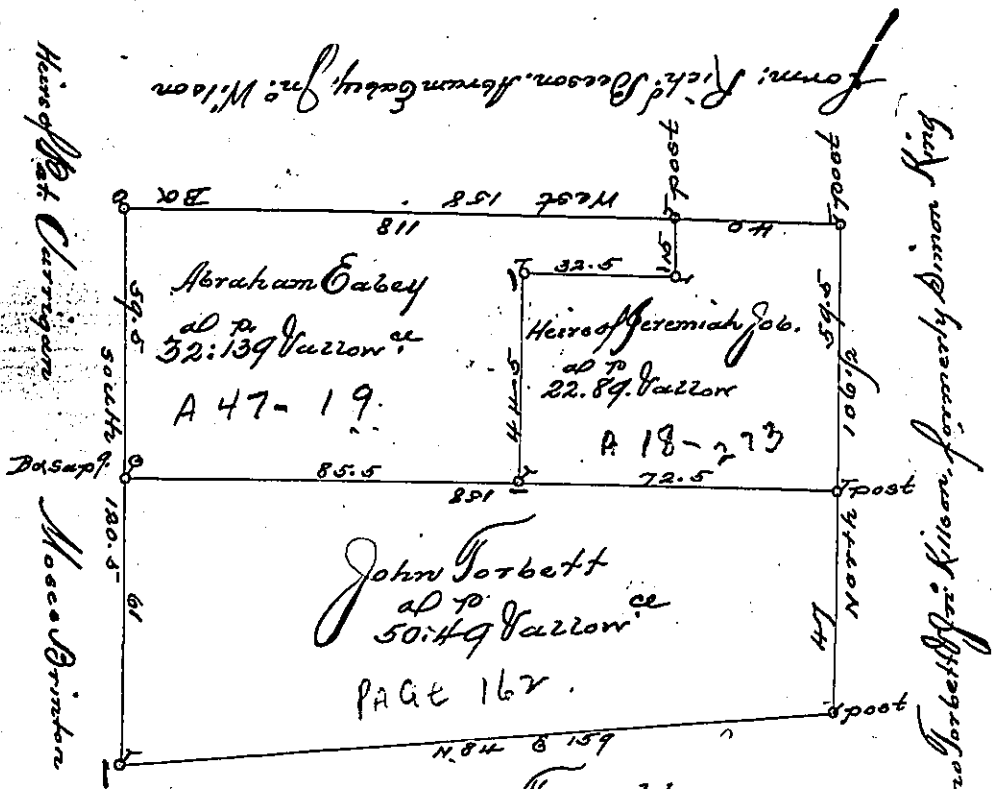


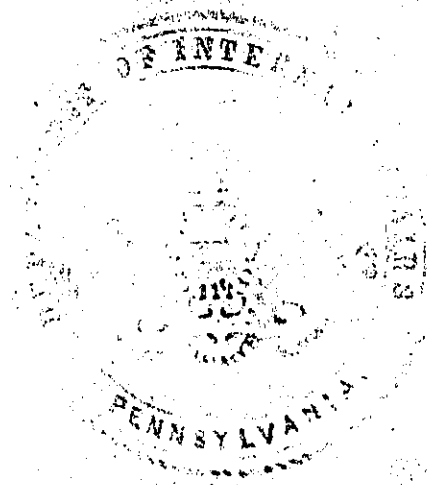

The above is the Draught of a Tract of Land situated in Leacock Town^{sh}: Lancaster County first Surveyed to Richard Beeson and Returned into the Secretarys Office the 19th May 1761 for Jacob Job. Returned according to the above Division for John Torbett, Abraham Casey, and Mary Hughey and Adam Woods in Trust for the children of Jeremiah Job, Dec^d. into the Secretarys Office the 30th Day of December 1771.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this fourth day of July, 1899.
