



A Draught of a Tract of Land situated in Derry Township Lancaster County Containing two hundred & twenty four acres and one quarter of an acre & the allowance of six acres additional for Roads & Highways, Survey'd by Thomas Cookson Engr obt. Dep't Sur of Lancaster County for Jacob Croyden in pursuance of warrant granted to Samuel Parke, bearing date at Philadelphia obd. 1<sup>st</sup> day of March 1737. The Field Book wherein the Notes of obd. above Survey are, seems to me to contain Mr. Cookson's first obd. and has no date. The Surveyor. Martin Croyder. son of Ja obd. intimated his father purchased the above described Tract of Land of Samuel Parke, and I find a Warrant in the name of Jacob Croyder obd. intimated same land bearing date the 3<sup>d</sup> June 1741. obd. extracted & calculated from the Field Book
