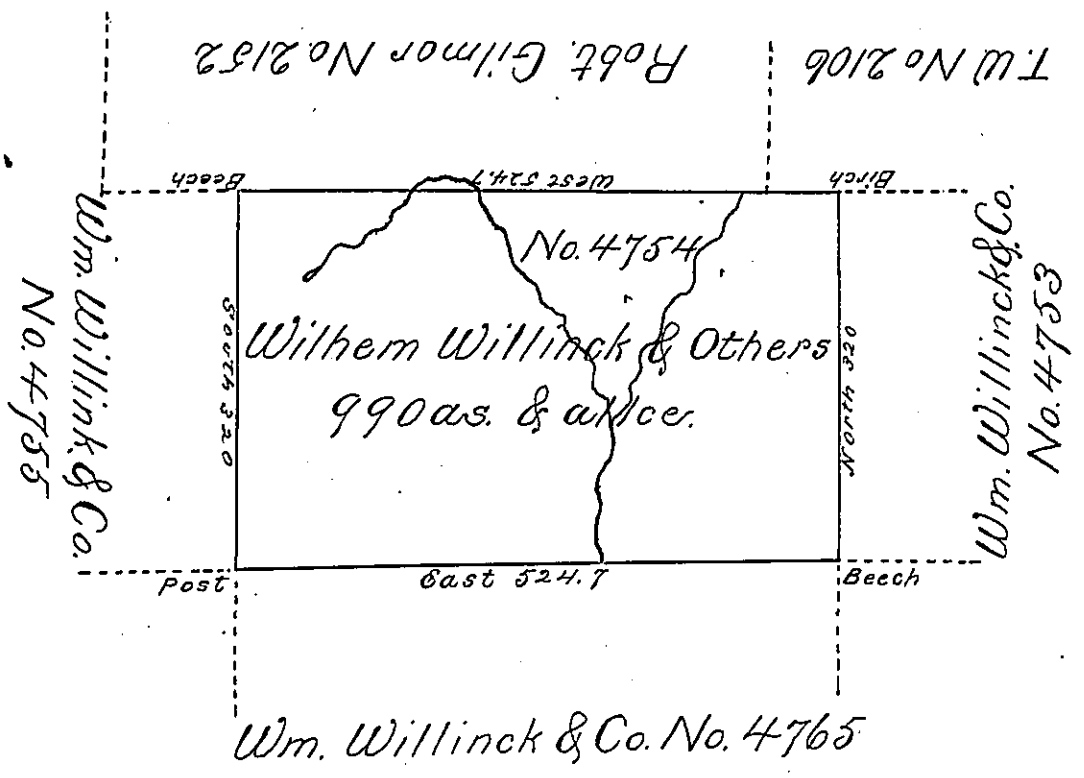


(East Fork Dist. - Potter)
