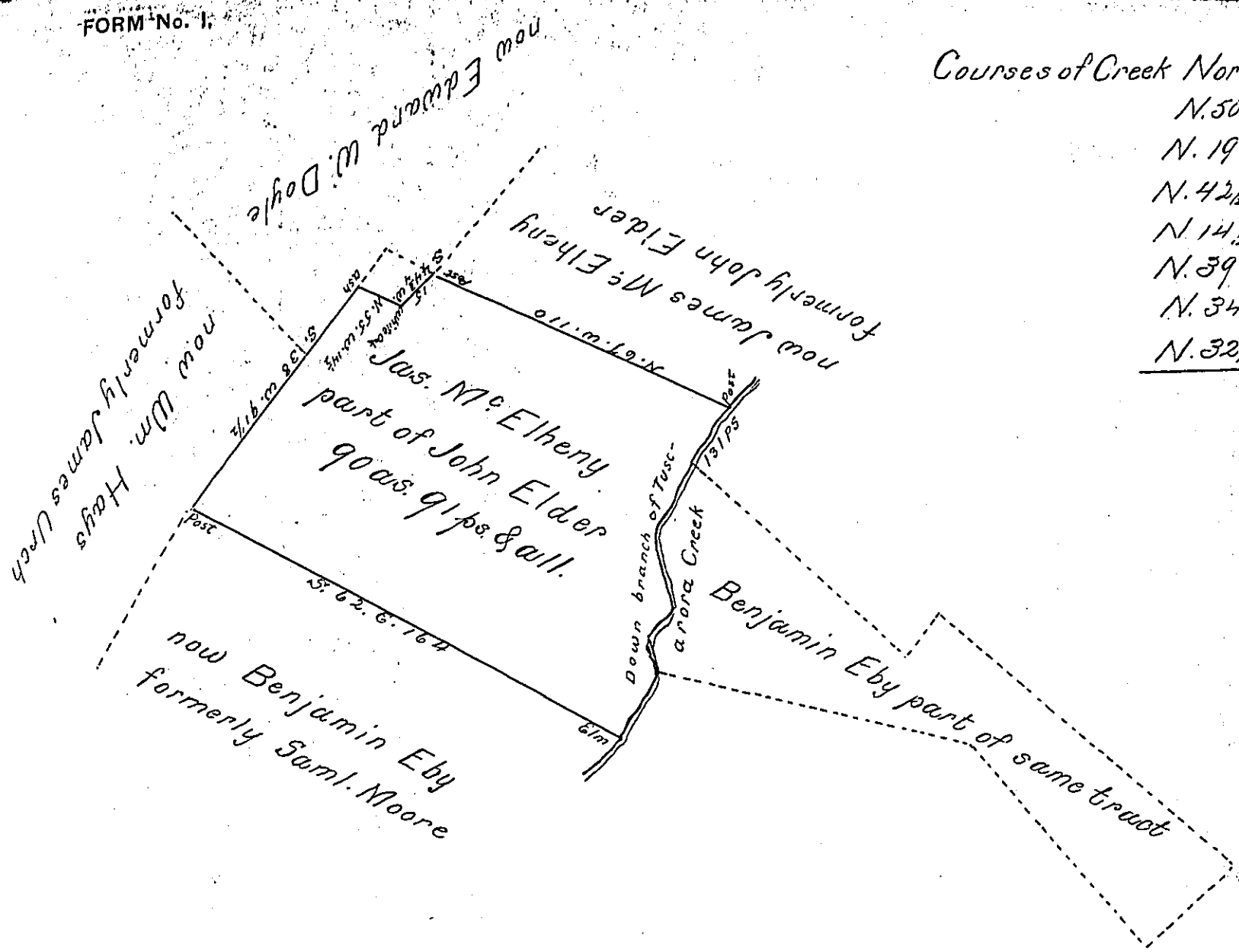

Davis then deputy Surveyor it being part of a larger tract of 137 ac. 90 ps. & allowance of Six percent for roads &c. Situate in Tannet township (formerly Cumberland now) Franklin County which was surveyed in pursuance of an application No. 3044 in the name of John Elder bearing date the 13th day of March 1767 Examined the above survey and found it to be correct. Certified this 24th day of November 1825
