



A Draught of a Tract of Land Situate in Soper Salford Township in the County of Philadelphia and Province of Pennsylvania. Containing Eighty nine acres of Land, together with the usual allowance at Six per cent for Roads - That formerly was Surveyd unto William Wirts [al Hertz] / In pursuance of a Warrant granted to him by the Honble Proprietaries, dated about the year 1735 or 1736 - Part of the Consideration for the same was afterwards paid by Jacob Tillman, after that Dietrich Helgar purchased the Right to the same, and build a Forge thereon: who now sold the same to John Kreyder -

Resurveyed for him on the 2d February Anno. 1769
