

Vacant Land

By Virtue of a Warrant from the Propretaries dated the thirteenth day of August 1734 Surveyed unto Andreas Tisher a tract of band Situate in Majetaving in the County of Philada Begining at a Black Oak in a line of Henry Harpmane land thence by the same South Ten deques East one hundred and Six perches to a White Oak Sapling them by the sd Carpmane land North Eighty deques East one hundred and Eight perches to a post thence by Jacant Kand South Eighty Seven perches to a post thence by Jacant Kand South Eighty dequese West two hundred and thirty five perches to a post thence by lacant land laid out to William Gross North ten dequeses west one hundred and Minety three perches to a post thence by Jacant land North Eighty degrees East one hundred and twenty seven perches to y place of Begining Containing two hundred and twenty seven perches to y place of Begining Containing two hundred and twenty seven perches to y place of Begining Containing two hundred answers with yeursual allowance of Six Shent.
