



A Draught of a Tract of Land called the Elk-Pasture (being part of a larger Tract of that Name) situated on the Waters of Otter Creek abt. Conemough between four and five miles above the forks & between the branches of the said Creek & near where the said branches interlock with Clearfield & the abt. Creeks adjoining Land of William Sheed in Frankstown Township in the Count of Bedford containing two hundred & eighty eight Acres and the usual Allowance of six pcent for Roads &c. Surveyed the 23 Day of September 1773 for Edward Bonsall by virtue of a Warrant Dated 23d. July in the same year, by
