



Situate in the Township of Jay & County of Clearfield containing three hundred & seventeen acres & one hundred & twenty perches & the usual allowance for Roads &c. Surveyed the 21st day of July 1838 by virtue of a Warrant dated the 18th day of June 1838

To John Taylor Esqr. Surveyor General. Saml. Fulton U.S.

Note - This Warrant is laid on the ground it was intended for, but is claimed by Daniel Rodgers by Improvement & Warrant dated the 23d. day of August 1813 but no survey in this office at the letter F. there is ten or twelve acres cleared but no fence & the house burned down when I was there. I found Key Hicks in a hut put up a few days before in the clear ground near F. who said he was holding by actual Settlement
