



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietaries dated the Twenty seventh day of February 1733 Surveyed unto John Alprick a Tract of Land Situate in Oley in the County of Philada. Beginning at a White oak a Corner of Joseph Kirkbrides land thence by the same North Sixty Seven degrees West Two hundred and Ten perches to a post thence by Land of Solomon Cole North Twenty degrees East one hundred and Twenty nine perches to a post in the line of Peter Hiltons land thence by the same South Sixty four degrees East Twenty four perches and the same course by land of William Roberts one hundred and Eighty five perches to a white Oak thence by the sd. Roberts and South Twenty degrees West Twenty perches and by land of Wm. Morgan the same Course Ninety five perches to ye place of Beginning Contain- ing one hundred & fifty acres with the Usual allowance of Six perches
