



By Virtue of a Warrt. from the Honble. the Proprietaries dated the Tenth day of February 1738 Surveyed on the twentieth of the same month to John Apple the above described Tract of Land Situate on Saccon Creek in the County of Bucks containing 155 1/2 acres with allowance of Six pcent.

A Warrt. ^{prior to this} was granted to Ulrick Bubble & a survey made in Pursu — obliterated — & sold his Improvmt. to John Apple & afterwards departed the province not having made him a Deed whereupon John Apple applies for the Warrt. above mensond.

Both Tracts together contain 248 1/2 acs.
