Note. An order of survey was granted to Jeremiah Geavin for 100^{as} "joining
Samuel Carbertson and Samuel Perry, between the Kittatinny Mountain & North
Mountain in Fannet Township dated 25. March 1767 N^o 3207, seems to locate a part of
the above land, but no evidence of any claim ^{is} under the same: the land being claimed
on the order to Johnston as above stated - Although Johnstons order would locate land further
southward. - James Riddle Esqr, owner. - David & George Riddle, occupants
