Having discovered by actual survey, that the above tract as returned by Mr. Matthews, interferes considerably with a survey made by him in pursuance of two Warrants granted to George Payne, one for 80^{ac} dated 1st April 1751, the other for 50^{ac} dated 28th April 1757. I have taken the Liberty to make a new return at the request of Mr. Kirtick, who owns the whole of the above tract, together with part of Paynes Survey, as represented by the Draught, all which is respectfully submitted to the Surveyor General
