



In pursuance of an order No 3628, dated the 8th of July 1769, survey for William Mitchell the above Tract of Land (called Coblers Hall) containing two hundred & twenty acres of 120 perches with an allowance proportioned to 6 qrs. Cont. Situate on the North side of Loyalhanna Creek, including a small run, and adjoining the Land of Charles Mitchell & Jno. Lambert in Bedford County. Surveyed the 11th of October 1769.
