



Situated near the head of Dunbars Run, including Dunbars Camp in Union and Wharton Townships Fayette County & Surveyed the 15th & 16th days of November 1831. In pursuance of a Warrant in the name of J Atkinson for 300 acres dated the 22nd October 1784. There is two small improvements on this land of 4 or 5 acres each, in a state of cultivation, two Cabins & families residing in them, may have been occupied 10. or 12 years, also an old field cleared about 40 years ago. now grown up with bushes, and the old Cabin fallen down many years ago
