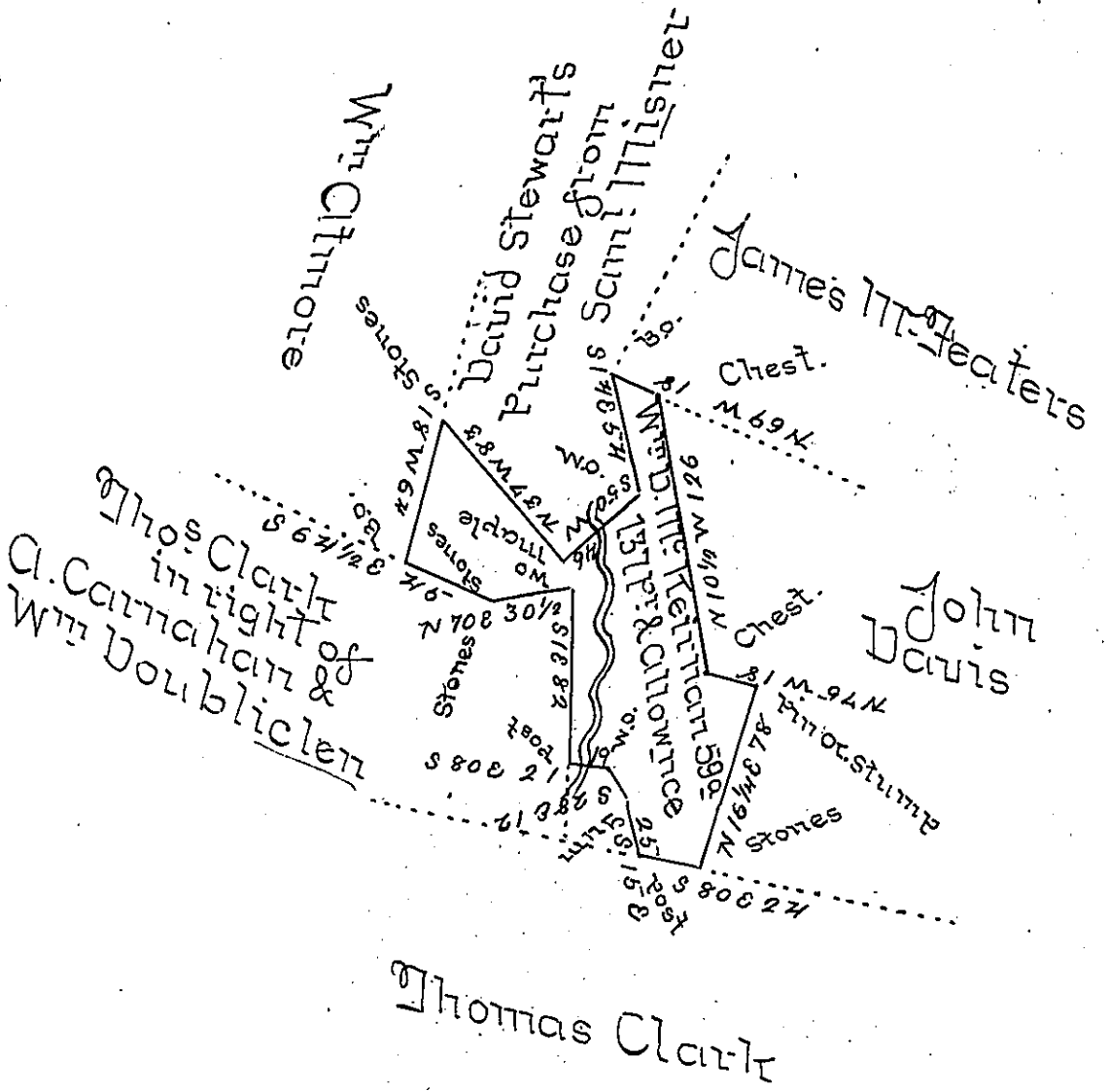

Surveyed to Wm D. McKeirnan on the 10<sup>th</sup> of August and the 12<sup>th</sup> & 13<sup>th</sup> of September A.D. 1844 the above described tract containing fifty nine acres and one hundred and thirty seven perches and allowance of six per cent situate in Brush Valley Township Indiana County Adjoining David Stewart's purchase from Samuel Mesner Thomas Clark and John Davis By Warrant of the 6<sup>th</sup> day of August A.D. 1844. N.B. David Stewart Caveats the survey alleging the right to the land is vested in him by virtue of an actual resident settlement which he supposes was commenced about year 1822 and continued ever since and therefore has abandoned the idea of having the Warrant he obtained (7<sup>th</sup> August 1844) executed on the land
