



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietaries Dated ye<sup>r</sup> twenty first day of February 1734 Surveyed unto Martin Alstadt a Certain Tract of Land Situate in Oley in the County of Philada Beginning at a Black Oak a Corner of Hans Martinis land thence by the same North West fifty four perches and by Vacant Land the same Course Severally Nine perches to a Corner Stone thence by Vacant Land North East one hundred and twenty eight perches to a Corner Stone thence by Vacant Land South East one hundred and thirty three perches to a post a Corner of said Alstadt's other Land thence by the same South West one hundred and twenty eight perches to the place of Beginning Containing one hundred Acres with the usual Allowance of Six Per Cent.
