



By Virtue of a Warrant dated the 13th December 1792 No 2883. there was surveyed the 26th August 1794 by William P. Brady (the former Deputy Surveyor) to William Willink, Nicholas Staphorst, Christian Van Eggar, Hendrick Wollenhoven and Rutger Jan Schummelpinnick the above described tract of Nine hundred twenty seven and an half acres & Allowance Situate on the waters of little Mahoning in District No 5 in the late purchase in the County of Wycoming a copy of remains in my Office.
