



By Virtue of a Warrant dated the 13th day of December 1792 No 2861 there was surveyed the 23^d August 1794 by William P. Brady the former Deputy Surveyor, to Wilhem Willink, Nicholas Van Staphorst, Christian Van Egan, Hendrick Wollenhoven, & Rutger Jan Schimmelpenninck the above described Tract of Nine hundred four acres and sixty five perches & Allowance Situate in District No 5 in the late purchase in the County of Lycoming a Copy of which remains in my Office -
