



By Virtue of a Warrant dated the 13th December 1792 No 2892, there was surveyed the 26th August 1794 by Wm P. Brady (the former Deputy Surveyor) to Wilhem Willink, Nicholas Van Staphorst Christian Van Egan, Hendrick Wollenhoven and Rutger Jan Schimmelpinninck the above described Tract of Nine hundred five acres & one hundred & twelve perches and allowance situate on the waters of Little Mahoning in District No 5 in the late purchase in the County of Lycoming. a copy of which remaining in my Office
