



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietaries dated the Eighth day of November 1734 Surveyed unto Henry Crupp a tract of Land Situate in Frederick Township in the County of Philada. Beginning at a post a Corner of Godlieb Hergar's land thence by the same North East one hundred and three perches to a post thence by land of George Fumbauer North West one hundred and three perches to a post thence by land of Phillip Fothergill South West one hundred and three perches to a post a Corner of sd. Crupp's other Land thence by the same South East one hundred & three perches to the place of Beginning Containing Sixty two acres <sup>8 a half</sup> with the usual allowance of Six pcent.
