



Surveyed on the tenth day of October 1733 to Garret Clements a certain Tract of Land Situate in the Township of Salford in ye County of Philada. Beginning at a corner post of Tilman Colphs land thence by ye same North West forty perches and by land late of Hugh Roberts the same course three hundred and Twenty Six perches to a post thence by Vacant Land North East three hundred & twenty perches to a white Oak a corner of Derick Johnsons land thence by that & land of Henry Rudd South East three hundred and Sixty Six perches to a post thence South West by Vacant land one hundred and twenty four perches & by land of Andrew Ledrah the same course one hundred & seventeen perches & by land of Tilman Colph ye same course seventy nine perches to ye place of Beginning Containing Six hundred & Ninety acres with usual allowance.
