



Situated formerly in Shirley Township Bedford County on the east side of Sideling Hill on the Head of the west Branch of three Spring Creek now Clay Township Huntington County Containing two hundred and forty one acres and forty one perch and the usual allowance of six per cent for roads &c. first surveyed the 13th day of June 1840 by William Reed D.S. In pursuance of a warrant granted to Charles Baker for 200 ac. dated the 26th day of February A.D. 1785 and resurveyed the 14th day of April 1863 and reexamined the 25th day of November A.D. 1868 for Daniel Curfman and found correct.
