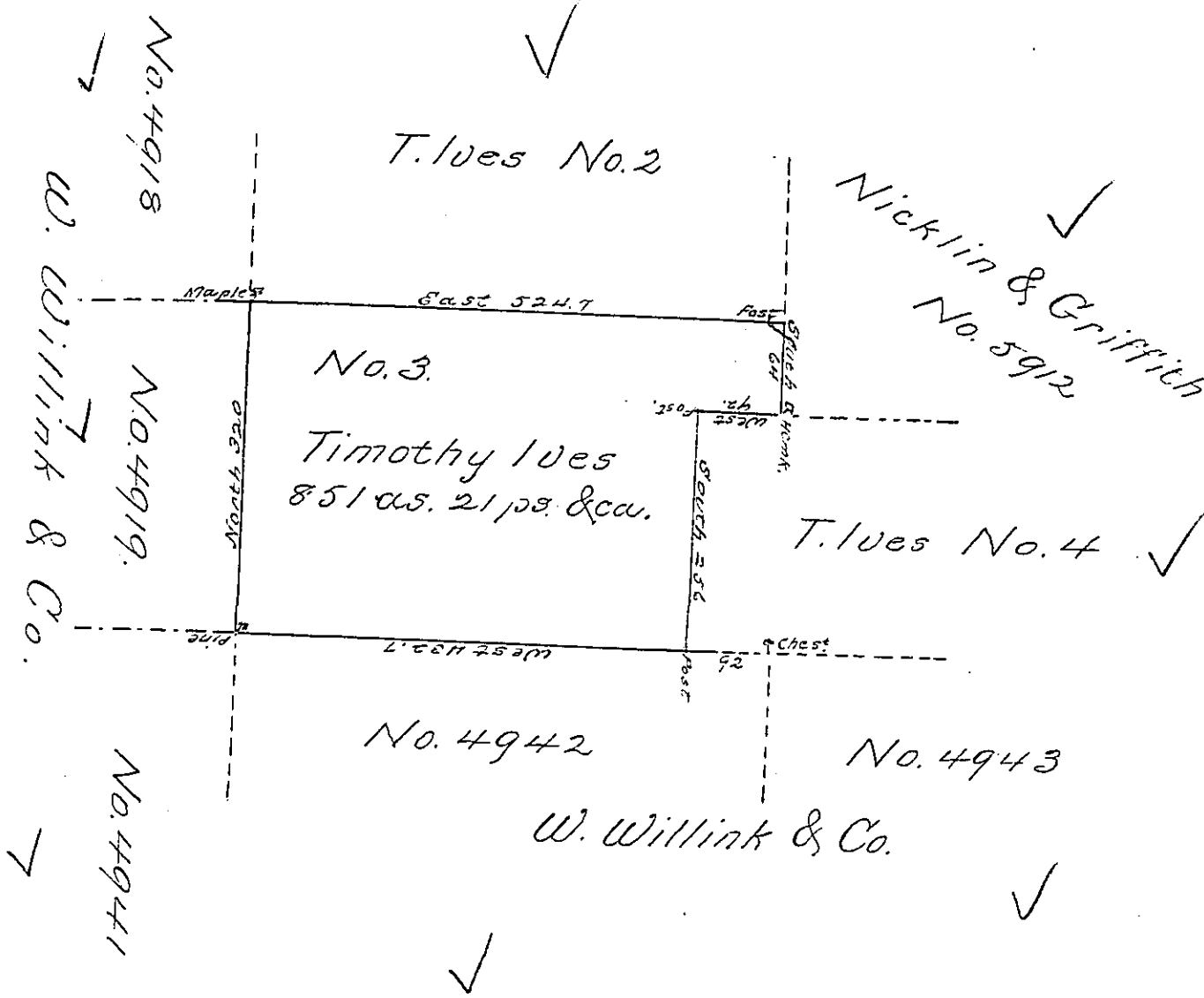


(Wharton - Potter)
