



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietor dated the 16th. day of August Anno Domini 1738 the above described Tract of Land was surveyed unto Christian Carpenter in the Township of Coccolico \* \* \* \* in Lancaster County Beginning at a White Oak at a Corner of Jacob Overhaltzer's land Thence South 10 Degrees West by Vacant Land 130 perches to a post &c. Containing One Hundred and forty seven acres beside the allowance of Six p. Cent  
 (28th. 1st. mo. 1739) p. Sam Lightfoot.
