



The above land is Situate on the Branches of Ictarus Run in Township of West Sadsbury & Co. of Lancaster

Surveyd by Jns. Churchman. Sept. 22nd. 1743 upon a hearing before his Honor the Gov. (Mr. James McKee being present on behalf of Mr. Craighead) John Churchman settg forth the particulars attendg the above Survey viz. That while he was on the Spot & before he had finished Craigheads survey he discovered an Error to have been made by the Chainmen & that the Lines were really longer than they made them upon which John expressed his dissatisfaction to Mr. Craighead & told him he would make no Return of what he had then done till he had examined the Lines by persons he could depend on and upon an examination of ye Lines he found them to contain ~~more~~ that quantity he then surveyd for Mr. Connell more than would satisfy Craigheads Warrt &c. &c. Whereupon his Honor was clearly of opinion that Mr. Connell should have his Land confirm'd to him as it is above described & Mr. McKee he had nothing to object.
