



Pursuant to order (No. 551) dated ye 20th. of August 1765. Surveyed ye 17th. Day of ye 12th. mo. 1765. the above Described Tract of Land Situate in East Fallowfield Township in Chester County for ye use of ye above named Andrew Olliphant & Including his Improvement — By — Benja Parwin.

N.B. The Land is chiefly poor if my skill be good except about 20 or 30 a. of ye N.W. Corner. A small Log House on ye premises built about 4 years ago & barn, about 36 a. cleared. Part whereof was cleared some years before ye house was built by a Person who had no family, who sold his Goodwill to it, according to ye Neighbour's testimony

Benja Parwin.
