


Proprietary of the State of Pennsylvania

Architectural Survey



Situate in Franklin Township in Northumberland County Surveyed on the 20th day of June 1820, by one of the Surveyors of the town of Rutherford granted to Joseph Whalley dated the 2nd day of June 1820. On a warrant to Whalley Rutherford dated the 8th Decr 1795 - Containing about six acres, four hundred & thirteen acres and the allowance of Sixteen bushels.

To Gabriel Fletcher Esq: Surveyor General.

I do herby acknowledge to William Laird D.S. on the 16th June 1833 by letter of his warrant dated the 2nd August 1800 & also before him an instrument made in 1797 on the last surveyed tract (which it does appear that said survey is a part of that now described by Wm Gray) he has laid to Wm Lambert I did not find - that this was never rectified or re-surveyed for Lambert by any authority from the Land Dept. but occurs to the one under a date stated in virtue of the order granted to Whalley to
