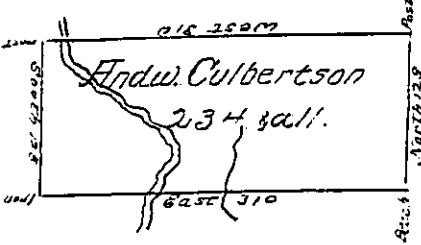

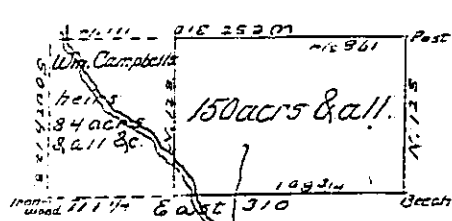

Andrew Culbertson's Improvement and settlement which last man settled under David McKean) were living on the land with their families and engaged in improving the same and to the best of my knowledge the land contained in sd. survey has not been claimed by any warrant or otherwise by any other person.
