



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietor Dated the 15th of December Anno Dom. 1737 The above Described Tract of Land was surveyed unto ^{the Township} Ewan Price in the County of Lancaster Beginning at a Hickery at a Corner of y^e Land of David Lewis thence East North East by Vacant Land eight perches to a Hickery thence Down the River Schuylkil on the several Courses thereof 331 perches to a Black Oak thence To 35 Degrees West by y^e Land of Ewan Price 40 perches to a Post thence West South West by y^e same 44 perches to a post thence North West by y^e Land of David Lewis 200 perches to y^e place of Beginning Containing Twenty Five Acres beside y^e allowance of six p Cent for Roads
