The lines & trees in the above survey show the original line to have been made in 1770 or 1771. - Since that time a Warrant was granted to a certain Jacob ~~Brown~~ ^{Brown}, dated the 13 April, 1790, and surveyed on the same ground, and returned, and I believe now patented, no draught to show the date of the original survey, there was once an improvement commenced on it, but abandoned long ago. -
