



In pursuance of a Law passed the 11<sup>th</sup> day of April 1799, for selling certain Reserved Tracts therein named, the Instructions of the State Governor dated the 14<sup>th</sup> day of May, 1799, and the Order of the Surveyor General dated the 18<sup>th</sup> day of May 1799, Surveyed the 12<sup>th</sup> day of October 1799, the above described Tract of Land being Tract No. 5, of the Reserved Tract called Erie (now) Erie County, Containing eighty seven acres and ninety two perches strict Measure.
