



In Pursuance of an Order from the Commissioner of Property Bearing date the 16<sup>th</sup> day of June 1872 a Dwyer was made on the 3<sup>d</sup> day of July following on a certain lot of Ground in the Town of Dunbury in the County of Northumberland marked in a General Plan of said Town Number Thirty-two, containing in Breadth East & West on Shamokin Street sixty feet, and in Length North and South two hundred and thirty feet. Bounded Northward by Shamokin Street aforesaid, Eastward by Lot Number Thirty-three, Southward by Barberry Alley, and Westward by Lot Number Thirty-one. — Returned into the Secretary's Office the 12<sup>th</sup> day of September 1874 by Warrant granted to David Fowler dated the 8<sup>th</sup> instant
