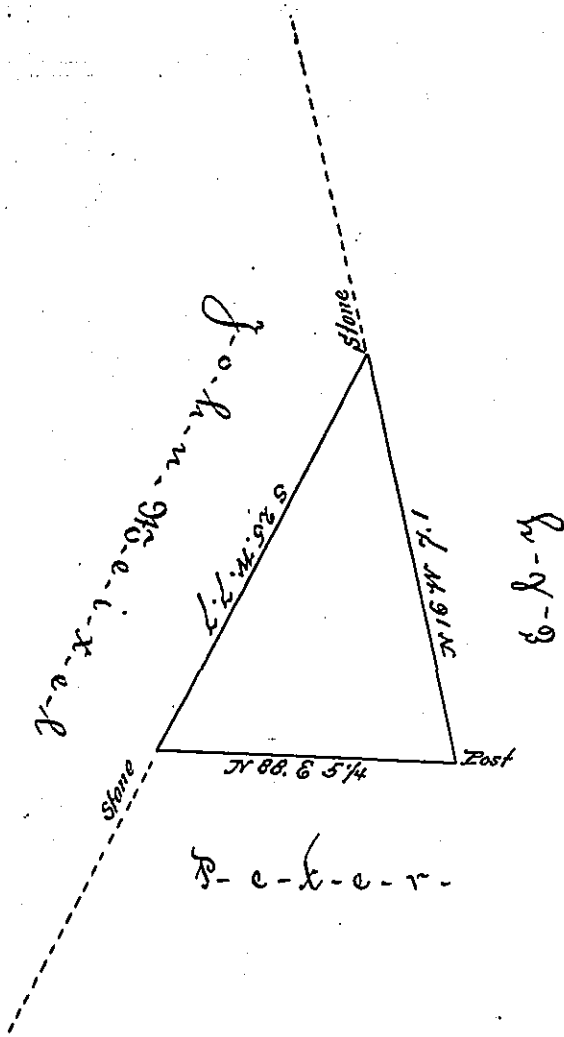


Set out Upper Leacock 235
