That the Commissioners appointed for adjusting the Claims to unpatented Lands in the Counties of Monongalia, Logan and the Ohio do hereby Certify that Richard Swan is intitled to four Hundred Acres of Land in the County of Monongalia on Houdy Creek to be bounded within the Lines marked out by him to include his Settlement made in the year of our Lord one Thousand seven Hundred & seventy

Given under our hands at Redstone Old Fort this sixteenth Day of November 1779, in the fourth year of the Commonwealth
