



Situate on both sides of Dumbar Run in Dumbar township Fayette County & Surveyed In pursuance of a Warrant in the name of said Meason for 400<sup>ac</sup> dated the 3<sup>d</sup> day of July 1793

I find the above Survey to be correct, and properly located, and Alex<sup>r</sup> McClean late Df. informs me that it was made by his direction by Morris Morris (from whose draft & Calculation I have taken it) some time in the Summer of 1795 and he thinks in the month of June of that year
