



Situated on the South Side of the road that leads to Nydes Ferry on Monongahela River and on the Waters of Georges Creek in Springhill Township Fayette County and Surveyed the 8th Day of February 1786 In Consequence of a Certificate granted by the Commissioners Appointed by the State of Virginia &c^a a Certificate of its being Entered with the Surveyor of Monongahela County is as follows.

Ent^d April 14th 1780. John Pierce Devaul Produced a Certificate from the Commissioners of Monongalia, Yohegania and Ohio for 400 acres of Land on Georges Creek to include his Settlement made 1773 also a right in preemption of 1000 Acres Dated 22^d Dec^r 1779.
