 about it, and part of a Cleared field, which field is said to be in the
 possession of Evans Turk - I further beg leave to state that Edward
 Kirkpatrick Claims the whole of the above Tract of Land. In pursu-

 patrick bearing date the 22nd day of July A.D. 1814.
