 ing three Hundred and ninety three Acres in pursuance of a Virginia Certificate Grant-
 ed in the following manner. We the Commissioners appointed for adjusting the Claims
 to unpatented Lands in the Counties of Meigs Wetzel and Ohio do hereby
 Certify that Enoch Dye is entitled to four Hundred acres of Land in the County of
 Ohio on the waters of Shirley creek to include his settlement made in the year of
 our Lord one thousand seven Hundred and seventy six

Given under our Hands at Redstone the sixteenth day of December 1780.
 in the fourth year of the Commonwealth
