



Surveyed to James Stewart on the 7<sup>th</sup> day of November 1812 the above described tract of one hundred and twenty six acres and one hundred and twenty eight perches, and allowance of six per cent adjoining lands of George Drimble, Archibald Stewart, Patrick Lucas, Joseph Kerr and others including an improvement situate in Armstrong (Westmoreland) now Indiana County by warrant of the 10<sup>th</sup> day of November Ad. 1800 as appears from papers remaining in my office -
