



Surveyed the 15th of December 1836 in pursuance of a warrant bearing date the 24th of May 1836 Granted to Daniel Shrockmorton. Situate on the waters of the Southfork of Seneca, Centre township in the county of Greene. Containing 418 acres and 127 perches and the allowance of 6 per cent, including and actual settlement and improvement. Called "Maintenance"
