



The Draught of a tract of land situate in Eastpembroke Township, Cumberland County containing 142 ⁹³/₁₀₀ acres with the usual allowance of six per cent for roads was surveyed the 5th day of June 1797 by Saul Ryan (then Deputy Surveyor) in pursuance of an order of court granted to Saul Fisher bearing date the 25th day of November Anno 1767 95th 4611.
