



The above is a draught of a tract of land situate on the west side of Monongahela river in Bethlehem township Washington County called Cherry Grove. Containing three hundred and fifty acres one hundred and ten perches and allowance of six p^{er}ches, which said tract (by the papers and documents in my possession) appears to have been surveyed the 19th day of February A.D. 1797 in pursuance of a warrant granted to Joseph Dorsey for 350^{ac} dated the 15th day of May 1796 - and resurveyed the 5th day of May 1823 -
